

FCEM OSCEs - April 2015

- Vomiting child - conflict with mother, the child has normal obs and sounds well, sibling had a similar presentation but had a perforated appendix and needed PICU, not happy with FY2 counsel with mother.
- Neck injury via translator - simple RTC/whiplash/ nexus guidelines.
- Ebola - advice for triage nurse who has seen an unwell patient returning from Liberia.
- Hip injury - Patient was a gymnast - exam and management.
- Seldinger chest drain - teach whilst doing - beware - you will be short for time.
- Electrocution - history, examination & management.
- Bloody diarrhoea. History and management
- APLS - 6 month in respiratory distress, wetflag, asystolic arrest, ROSC, picu
- Peripheral nerves upper limb (radial nerve palsy) - exam, history and management
- Greater auricular nerve block - teach how to do
- Lost condom - sexual history
- OD cocaine - history and management
- ATLS - cyclist RTC, tension pneumothorax, teach drain, class 4 shock, pelvis#, abdo free fluid, needs theatre difficult referral to surgical consultant
- Low sodium - marathon runner had a seizure - give advice to the FY2 on management
