## OSCE Stations FCEM 2012

1. Teaching station – show a medical student how to use an ophthalmoscope
2. Teaching station - teach a medical student about arterial blood gases
3. Teaching major incident triage (4 patients) to a new charge nurse.
4. ATLS – double station – RTC - 1 yr old child RTC head injury and femoral shaft fracture
5. Practical skills - Suturing station
6. Practical skills - Urinary catheterisation
7. Communication - Needlestick injury. History and discussing risk factors, need PREP?
8. Communication – Child presents with likely transient synovitis. Mother requesting orthopaedic opinion.
9. Communication – Breaking bad news for a paediatric death
10. A patient presents with a history of depression. Obtain full history and risk stratify (SADPERSONS score) and perform capacity assessment
11. A patient presents with dysuria – obtain a sexual health history
12. A patient presents with haematemesis and has non hodgkins patient with good prognosis
13. ALS station – Team leadership in ALS scenario
14. CVS examination
15. A patient presents with a head injury with GCS 14 , NICE guidance.
16. PNS examination
