OSCE Stations FCEM Spring 2013

1. Teaching station – teach corner flap suturing to one of your ANPs
2. Hip examination in a patient with trochanteric bursitis
3. Patient presents with fast AF. Perform synchronised cardioversion under conscious sedation and explain ongoing management.
4. CDU ward round – Elderly patient with collapse ?cause (ECG changes – trifascicular block), intoxicated patient with GCS 13, abdominal pain in a young woman (consider pregnancy)
5. APLS, trauma scenario – 5 yr old pedestrian RTC with haemothorax and free fluid in the abdomen
6. Left sided abdo pain – history suggestive of renal colic – CT KUB showing stones
7. Patient presents with syncope (?micturating syncope)
8. ALS – Patient presents with bradycardia (complete heart block) and chest pain needing transcutaneous pacing
9. Patient presents with a fever for 4 weeks – obtain full history and develop management plan
10. Teaching station - Seldinger chest drain.
11. PNS examination – lower limb - common peroneal nerve palsy following plaster cast application
12. Communication station – explain to mother of a 14 yr old girl that you think she has Addison's Disease
13. Communication station – convince senior nurse that a child needs referral to paediatrics with ?NAI
14. Obtain a history and perform a mental state assessment in a patient with drug induced psychosis
